3. Points of Discussion

Mr. Aaron E. Wilkins, ACP Co-Chair (USG) kicked-off the ACP Board meeting on August 27, 2010 and welcomed the ACP members. He informed that ACP-India has done more seminars than actual project as compare to the ACP-China. Now we should concentrate more on projects than seminars. Further he emphasized on a few points of **“Take ACP to the Next Level”**. These are

- ii. Presentations by ACP member companies during the ACP Board meetings (to brief the group on their company’s profile & mission). In this meeting “Pro-Mark Associates” briefed about their company profile and products.

4. Dashboard of Projects & Proposal

Dr. Arjun Singh, Program Director-ACP reviewed the “Project Status” and briefed to members. Overall, ACP is doing well from a project perspective. Regarding “Projects & Active Proposals with the USTDA,” please refer to the four square charts presented during the ACP Board meeting.

- a.) **Technical Training for Aerospace** approved ACP project. ACP Secretariat had invited Members Company for taking responsibility of **“Team Lead”** as HIECO shown inability to continue this project. The following company shown initial interest :

But Hi-Tec has given confirmation for accepting the responsibility. Based on the input received from members, ACP Board has decided that the new **“Team Lead”** for the project under reference is **“Hi-Tec Systems”**.

- b.) **Helicopter Aviation Safety Technical Assistance** – Bell Helicopter has informed to ACP Board that on September 20, 2010, they will get Helipad drawing from M/s Jacob Engineering for Delhi & Mumbai airport.

4.1 Proposal under Processing /Development/ Consideration:

- a. **Technical, Management, & Operational Development Training [TMODT]:**

Project Lead of this project is **“Hi-Tec Systems”** & Dr. Kalpana Jain, Vice President (Education and Training), Hi Tec Systems is the key person for this project. This proposal has been submitted to USTDA on August 26, 2010 & also confirmed by Mr. Henry Steingass, Regional Director (USTDA).

- b. **AAI ATCO Manpower Assessment [AAI Cost Share]:**

This project has been approved by USTDA board and Grant offer letter had been signed on July 13, 2010 by AAI & Contract Agreement of this project will be signed in the third week of September, 2010 between WCG & AAI which is confirmed by USTDA.

4.2 Proposals under Development

a. ATM Processes & Procedures Implementation

This project is follow-on project of ATM Training Program (ATMTP) and the final report had been submitted to Airports Authority of India (AAI). This project will be discussed in detail for developing TOR when WCG sign the contract for 4.1 (b) in AAI Corporate Headquarter (CHQ).

b. Airport Regulatory & Financing Pilot for Regional Airport

This project is a new proposal and it is follow-on of high level roundtable conference held in March 2, 2010 at Hyderabad. Next step is to meet the Chairman AAI, to understand the requirement and define ACP role in it.

c. Safety Management System Development Plan [DGCA cost Share]

Three ACP member companies i.e. CSSI, Hi-Tec & Accenture had shown keen interest to work on this project. As per SMS team Accenture has agreed to participate as a team member & Team Lead is Hi-Tec Systems and TOR of this project has been discussed with DGCA on August 26, 2010 & some input is expected from DGCA to finalize the proposal as soon as possible.

4.3 Proposals under Consideration

a. AAI CNS Manpower Assessment [AAI cost Share]:

This project is follow-on to the ATCO Manpower Assessment. Again, the AAI has re-iterated its interest in this project. This project will be discussed for developing the TOR when WCG sign the contract for 4.1 (b) in AAI CHQ.

b. Study on “Next-Gen/SESAR Technology” Requirement for India

This is a new proposal. AAI decide from the Team Lead to submit white paper on “Next-Gen/SESAR Technology” before processing to finalize the TOR. The submission date has been rescheduled for July 2, 2010.
