4. Dashboard of Projects & Proposal

Dr. Arjun Singh, Program Director-ACP reviewed the "Project Status" and briefed to members. Overall, ACP is doing well from a project perspective. 4.1 Projects underway

a. Technical Training for Aerospace Industry:

- i. Grant Amendment changing the Contractor for this activity from HEICO Parts Group Inc., to Hi-Tec Systems Inc., has been approved by USTDA and countersigned by the DGCA on October 22, 2010
- ii. Contract Agreement had been reviewed by Hi-Tec and delivered to DGCA on 22nd Oct 2010
- **b.** Helicopter Aviation Safety Technical Assistance Bell Helicopter has informed to ACP Board that they will get Helipad drawing from M/s Jacob Engineering for Delhi & Mumbai airport.

c. AAI ATCO Manpower Assessment [AAI Cost Share]:

This project Contact Agreement has been received for AAI Signature and expected to be signed 29th Oct 2010.

4.2 Proposal under Processing

a. Technical, Management, & Operational Development Training [TMODT]:

Hi-Tec Systems has sent the initial reply to Desk Study Team of USTDA and expected to be completed by 25th Oct 2010

b. Study on "Next-Gen/SESAR Technology" Requirement for India

This project is under desk study review & AAI has shown interest to share the cost of this project. The request has been sent to AAI by USTDA for 20-40% cost share.

c. GBAS Pilot Project at Chennai Airport

Proposal has been submitted to USTDA for desk study and expected to be approved in Nov 2010.

4.3 Proposals under Development

a. ATM Processes & Procedures Implementation

This project is follow-on project of ATM Training Program (ATMTP) and the final report had been submitted to Airports Authority of India (AAI). This project will be discussed in detail for developing TOR when WCG sign the contract for 4.1 (c) in AAI Corporate Headquarter (CHQ).

b. Airport Regulatory & Financing Pilot for Regional Airport

This project is a new proposal and it is follow-on of high level roundtable conference held in March 2, 2010 at Hyderabad. The small progress has been made by SDG and had a presentation to the ACP Board. Next step to meet USFCS officials and based on the outcome meeting will be fixed with Chairman AAI.

c. Safety Management System Development Plan [DGCA cost Share]

TOR of this project had been discussed with DGCA on August 26, 2010 & Team Lead is in contact with DGCA to get initial input to prepare the proposal of the project. [**No Progress**]
